

Remove Rows with Multitudinous Fields

Description

A field is considered to be multitudinous if its contents can be split into multiple elements according to a *separator* string. This algorithm filters the rows of a table by the number of elements in a *specified column*. It expects a *separator* string to be specified, which is used to split the *specified column* into 0 or more elements. It also expects a *non-inclusive upper threshold*. Rows are kept if their element count (according to the *specified separator*) in the *specified column* are below this *threshold*.
